Enjoy a cycling holiday to Amsterdam

Starting from Croydon on Wednesday 11th September 2019 the Worshipful Company of Constructors is organising a bicycle ride to Amsterdam (remember the tulips!), where the team hopes to arrive on Sunday 15 September 2019.

The route is mainly flat (after Dover), and the cyclists will be accompanied by support teams in cars. Everybody in the team will be fed and watered regularly (including lunch in local bistros and isotonic drinks) and will be accommodated in suitable hotels at each night-time stop. Whilst the route will NOT be marked a GPS file will be downloaded to each cyclist.

To take part in this ride, either as a cycling participant (limited to 30 cyclists) or as a helper you will need to pay at least £700 per person including VAT direct to the Company to cover the cost of the event. Any monies in excess of this should be paid to the WCC Charitable Trust and if these monies are personal then they can attract gift aid, which will add 25% to your donation at no cost to you.

Any surplus funds (we hope to raise at least £10,000) will be disbursed by the Company and the WCC Charitable Trust to The Prince's Trust Built Environment Group who work strategically with The Prince's Trust to open talent pipelines and support young people into the Built Environment industry through employability solutions.
