Come and watch the longest, grandest and most meticulously organised procession in the world go by (all three miles of it). The day is totally informal—just turn up at St Mary le Bow. You will only need to book if you wish to have lunch with us at Ironmongers' Hall. (We are using Ironmongers' Hall this year as the Little Ship Club will not be open).

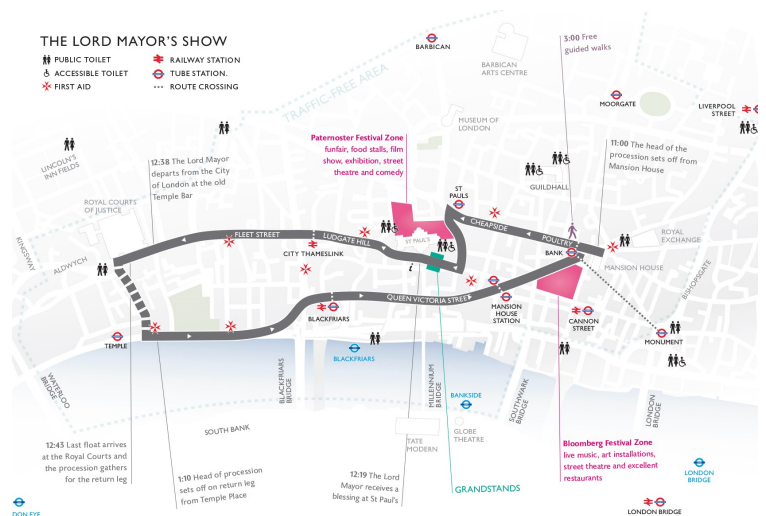
For the Lord Mayor's Show itself the Constructors' spectating contingent traditionally views the procession from the south side of Cheapside in front of the church of St Mary-le-Bow (EC2V 6AU) - the church whose bells are credited with having persuaded Dick Whittington to turn back from Highgate some 620 years ago. We gather here from 10:00.

The head of the procession leaves Mansion House at 11:00 with the procession gradually being zipped together from three moving streams to create a single broad parade that will take over an hour to go past our vantage point. But from wherever Constructors view the show, all are invited to join together for an informal hot buffet lunch at Ironmongers' Hall.

Constructors having lunch should arrive at Ironmongers Hall at around 12:30 and the buffet lunch at 12:45. A cash bar will be available serving beer, wine and soft drinks. Ironmongers' Hall will be open until 16:00.

The Hot Buffet lunch will cost £31 (inc VAT) for adults and £15.50 (inc VAT) for children under 14 years of age. When booking for lunch please specify the number of adults and children in your party.

Those watching the parade from St Mary-le-Bow will be guided to Ironmongers' Hall, those watching from elsewhere should head northwards up Aldersgate Street from the Museum of London roundabout.
