Choral Evensong

Located on the Cathedral Floor, Evensong is the treasure of the worship here at St Paul's. It is a service of sung Evening Prayer, taken from the Book of Common Prayer of 1662.

This meditative and reflective service lasts for around 45 minutes. The service is led by the choir, who sing responses, canticles, an anthem, and the psalms set for the day on our behalf, allowing us to experience the beauty of the music in this iconic setting. There are some readings from the Bible, and Prayers are said for the Church, the World and ourselves.

Cathedral and Crypt Tour

There will be a private tour led by an expert guide, where we will tour the Cathedral Floor, the Whispering Gallery and the Crypt.

Numbers are limited to 15, therefore early booking is recommended to avoid disappointment. Open to all members and their guests.
